

# SUMMER READING

As you read the play, you will need to keep a double-entry journal. You should have a total of ten items. All work should be your thoughts only; this is NOT a collaborative effort. Your responses should not parrot those done by your peers. If they do, I will consider your work to be plagiarized.

Divide your paper in half as demonstrated.

<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Write your explicit textual evidence in this space with <b>page numbers</b>.</li><li>2. You may include one entry or multiple entries on a page.</li><li>3. A typed assignment is preferred.</li><li>4. This may be shared with me via Google Docs using <a href="mailto:charlie.mccoin@sumnerk12.net">charlie.mccoin@sumnerk12.net</a>.</li><li>5. If you handwrite it, it must be in ink, and do not write on the back of the paper.</li><li>6. This assignment will be graded, and neatness counts.</li></ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Share what prompted you to include your textual evidence or why you feel it is noteworthy.</li><li>2. Explain why this quote connects to the rest of the work as a whole. What makes it significant?</li><li>3. Write a personal response to this quote. How does this quote affect you emotionally? What connections or relevance to your own life do you find?</li></ol>

No matter which semester you have Honors English IV, this assignment is due on the first day of class. The reading log is a prerequisite. Class changes will not be made after the first week of the semester for any reason. You will need to have a strong work ethic, strong reading skills, and a mastery of grammar in order to do well in class. There will be homework often and you will have to study frequently.
